## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Prevent Discrimination5 in Title X Act".

## 1 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISCRIMINATION.

2 Section 1006 of the Public Health Service Act (42
3 U.S.C. 300a-4) is amended by adding at the end the fol4 lowing:

5 "(e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
6 Secretary may not require any State, individual, or other
7 entity to counsel or refer for abortions as a condition for
8 receiving funding under this title.".
